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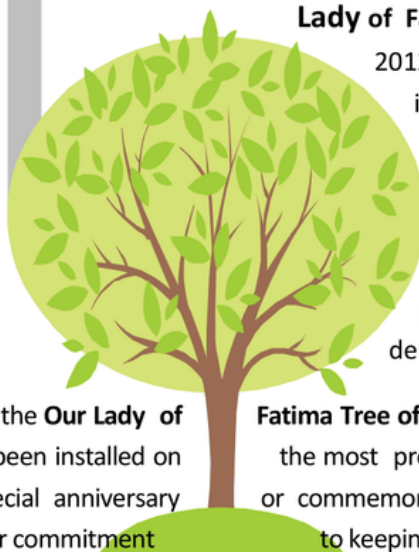

Eucharistic Rosary Congress 2026

This September and October, hundreds of parishes across the U.S. will participate in the 2026 Eucharistic Rosary Congress praying the rosary every hour for seven days and nights in front of the Blessed Sacrament in response to Our Lady of Fatima's call to conversion, consecration and prayer!



The Congress originated in Poland, in 1979, when Pope John Paul II (now Saint) desired to visit there but the communist Polish government would not permit him to travel to certain parts of his homeland. "Through a private revelation, Our Lady requested seven days and nights of continuous rosaries to be said before the Blessed Sacrament at the shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa. The prayers were to be offered for a resolution of the impasse preventing the papal pilgrimage." The Polish people held the first ERC as instructed. On the seventh and last day of the Congress, the communist government "unexpectedly relented and removed all obstacles to the papal visit." The Pope's subsequent visit to Poland is credited with the beginning of the fall of communism in that part of the world—the Berlin Wall fell in 1989.

The dates for our parish participation this year are Sept 19-26. Sign ups will be coming soon.

Congreso Eucarístico del Rosario 2026

¡Este mes de septiembre y octubre, cientos de parroquias en todo Estados Unidos participarán en el Congreso Eucarístico del Rosario 2026, rezando el rosario cada hora durante siete días y siete noches ante el Santísimo Sacramento, en respuesta al llamado de Nuestra Señora de Fátima a la conversión, la consagración y la oración!

El Congreso se originó en Polonia en 1979, cuando el Papa Juan Pablo II (hoy santo) deseaba visitar el país, pero el gobierno comunista polaco no le permitía viajar a ciertas zonas de su tierra natal. «A través de una revelación privada, Nuestra Señora pidió que se rezaran rosarios continuamente durante siete días y siete noches ante el Santísimo Sacramento en el santuario de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa. Las oraciones debían ofrecerse para lograr una solución al estancamiento que impedía la peregrinación papal». El pueblo polaco celebró el primer Congreso siguiendo estas indicaciones. En el séptimo y último día del Congreso, el gobierno comunista «cedió inesperadamente y eliminó todos los obstáculos para la visita papal». A la posterior visita del Papa a Polonia se le atribuye el inicio de la caída del comunismo en esa parte del mundo; el Muro de Berlín cayó en 1989.

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time
Matthew 16:13-2

The first time I stood inside St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome, its majesty overwhelmed me. The sheer beauty of Michelangelo’s dome seemed to lift my soul right out of my body. Later, I joined the Scavi tour that winds below the basilica, down into the ancient pagan cemetery where Peter was buried. There, in the dim light and narrow passageways, I found myself looking at the bones of a murdered Jewish fisherman, his feet cut off so his crucified body could be taken down more easily.

What a paradox. Above me, the most glorious church ever built. Beneath me, the remains of a backwater fisherman. But this man dared to answer Jesus’ question, **“Who do you say that I am?”** And crowning that immense dome above his tomb are the words from today’s Gospel, **“You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.”**

Within you and me is the drama of the lowest and the highest. Every time we confess Christ, humbly, imperfectly, maybe even trembling, we enter that same mystery. The dust of our humanity, touched by the splendor of heaven. God’s presence and our dry bones together. Humility and glory. May our lives embrace both the lowest and the highest, like that great basilica, as we profess Jesus

SAINT Spotlight

This week we celebrate two saints, a mother and son: St. Monica and St. Augustine. As a young Christian woman, St. Monica was married to a pagan. Early in their marriage, he was bitter and critical. After nearly 20 years, Monica’s holy example led to his conversion to Christianity. In the meantime, Augustine was a teenager beginning to live a wild life of self-indulgent excess. This lifestyle would continue into his adulthood. Like with her husband, Monica prayed and fasted for the conversion of her son. Augustine met another future saint, the bishop Ambrose of Milan, who greatly influenced his perspective on life. Augustine was baptized a Christian! Augustine later became a bishop and one of the most influential thinkers in Christian history.

How’s that for the power of patience and intercessory prayer?

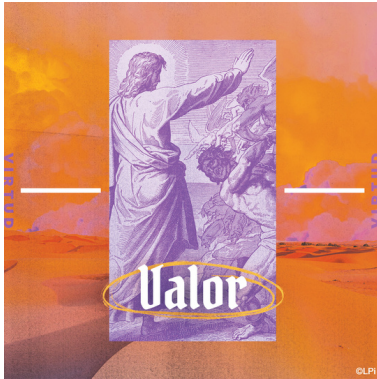

¡Valor, Explicado!

Aunque el valor en sí mismo no es una virtud cardinal ni teológica, como palabra latina que significa "fortaleza", a menudo lo asociamos con el don de la fortaleza. Concretamente, evoca una imagen de fortaleza en el campo de batalla — de fidelidad a la buena lucha, independientemente del ataque que se avecina.

Cuando Cristo preside la Última Cena en el Evangelio de Juan, habla a sus Apóstoles sobre las persecuciones que pronto sufrirán él y ellos. También habla del Abogado (el Espíritu Santo) que "te guiará hacia toda la verdad" — una elección significativa, ya que la fortaleza no es solo una virtud, sino un don del Espíritu Santo.

"He aquí, la hora se acerca... cuando cada uno de vosotros se disperse... y me dejaréis solo", les dice Cristo. "Pero no estoy solo, porque el Padre está conmigo."

En el mundo, concluye, habrá dolor y sufrimiento. "Pero tengan valor, he conquistado el mundo." (Juan 16:13-33)

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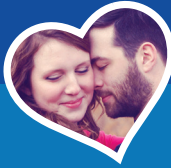
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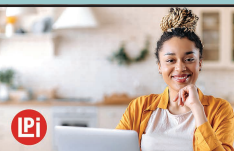
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
