Experience Eucharistic Revival at the Eucharistic Rosary Congress

At all times of life, the faithful are encouraged to renew our worship of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, and to encounter His healing grace. We have the perfect opportunity to do so during the Eucharistic Rosary Congress, which is a seven-day period of Eucharistic Adoration and Hourly Rosary in response to **Our Lady of Fatima's** call to conversion, consecration, and prayer. It is offered in a spirit of reparation to restore the sanctity of life, to heal families, establish peace in our cities, nation, and world, and to console the hearts of Jesus and Mary.

St. Joseph's will host the Eucharistic Rosary Congress Sept 19-26 for 7 days and nights. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in the Adoration chapel with the Rosary prayed aloud at the start of each hour, followed by silent prayer for the remainder of the hour. Prayers with the special intentions for each decade of the Rosary are provided.

Two participants are required for each hour. Please consider by volunteering to cover one or more of the hours of Adoration during the day or the night hours. Bring your family, a friend, or if you are part of a parish group, consider inviting your group to pray a Holy Hour. **Eucharistic adorers who will lead a rosary in English or Spanish during their Holy Hour can sign up in the Chapel.**

Catholic Considerations for Our Earthly Passing

Consideraciones católicas para nuestra partida a la otra vida

A NOTE ON GENERAL PRINCIPLES

No summary can substitute for thorough catechesis, but some general principles are clear. We are entrusted by God with the gift of life, and in response, we care for our lives and health in obedience and gratitude to our Creator.

This obliges us to make use of appropriate, effective medical care. However, even effective treatments may at times impose such a great burden that we, in good conscience, may forgo or discontinue them. This applies even to life-sustaining treatments. Of course, nothing should be done or deliberately omitted to hasten death.

The Church affirms the inviolable dignity of every person, regardless of the duration or extent of the person's incapacity or dependency. Nothing diminishes the unchangeable dignity and sanctity of a person's life, or the obligation to protect and care for it. In principle, assisted feeding and hydration should be provided unless it cannot sustain life or is unduly burdensome to the patient, or if death is imminent whether it is provided or not. Moreover, no one should choose suicide, nor counsel or assist another to take his or her own life.

PRINCIPIOS GENERALES

Un resumen no sustituye una catequesis profunda, pero algunos principios generales son claros. Dios nos ha confiado el don de la vida, y como respuesta, cuidamos la vida y la salud en obediencia y gratitud a nuestro Creador.

Esto nos obliga a buscar atención médica adecuada y eficaz. Sin embargo, algunas veces tratamientos eficaces y hasta de soporte vital imponen una carga tan grande que, en conciencia, podemos renunciar a ellos o interrumpirlos. Y por supuesto, no se debe hacer ni omitir nada deliberadamente para acelerar la muerte.

La Iglesia afirma la dignidad inviolable de toda persona, independientemente de la duración o extensión de la incapacidad o dependencia de la persona. Nada disminuye la inmutable dignidad y santidad de la vida de una persona, ni la obligación de protegerla y cuidarla. En principio, se debe proporcionar alimentación e hidratación asistida salvo en casos en los que no pueda dar soporte vital o sea indebidamente gravosa para el paciente, o si la muerte es inminente.

Además nadie debe elegir el suicidio, ni aconsejar o ayudar a otro a quitarse la vida.
